## Crafts

### Day 1: Olympic Sidewalk Chalk

- Using sidewalk chalk, draw your favorite Olympic sport scene
  - Make sure to leave a blank spot for yourself
  - Ex: Soccer, Gymnastics, Running, Swimming, etc.
- Complete with an Olympic logo and country name of your choice (USA, right?)
- Lay on the sidewalk and pose in the picture as one of the characters

#### **Materials:**

- large paper plate
- green and light green construction paper
- scissors
- glue
- tape
- ribbon

#### **Directions:**

1. Cut the center out of a large paper plate.
2. Cut about a quarter out of the ring, so it fits the head better.
3. Cut many simple leaves from green and light green paper.
4. Start at the back end of the paper plate rim and start gluing the leaves in alternating colors down one side, then the other.
5. Continue gluing the leaves together past the ends of the paper plate a few inches.
6. Secure the bottom of the leaves that extend out with some tape.
7. Tie a ribbon around the back of the wreath.

### Day 3: Toilet Paper Bunny

#### **Materials:**

Toilet Paper Roll  
Paint, markers or crayons  
White cardstock/paper  
Colored cardstock/paper  
Glue  
Black Sharpie  
(Optional) Googly eyes

(Optional) Pipe cleaners

**Directions:**

1. Color your roll white
2. Make the bunny ears by tracing out ears on white cardstock and then making a smaller ear insert with some colored paper of your choice.
3. Glue two small googly eyes to your paper roll. (Or color on)
4. Then twist three small pipe cleaners around each other and glue this down to the paper roll for the whiskers. (Or color on)
5. Glue the ears to the inside of the top of your paper roll. Then draw on the mouth with a black sharpie.

Day 4: Marker Easter Eggs

**Materials:**

- Boiled Eggs
- Ziploc like bags
- Washable Markers
- Damp Rag

**Directions:**

1. Grab a clean, plastic bag like a Ziploc.
2. Lay the clear plastic on a white piece of paper.
3. Color the plastic with washable markers. Preferably with quick, random splotches of color.
4. Wipe the boiled egg with a damp cloth and quickly wrap the damp egg in colored plastic with marker side on the egg.
5. Wipe any leftover and repeat as desired.

Day 5: He is Risen Plates

**Materials:**

- Paper Plate
- Construction paper
- Markers or paint
- Black Sharpie
- Scissors
- Glue

**Directions:**

1. Take paper plate and color a rainbow on 1/2-2/3 of your plate.
2. On the remaining area of your plate, color green for grass.
3. Set aside and let dry.
4. On yellow construction paper trace your hand and cut out.
5. Also, on black or brown construction paper, draw a cross roughly the size of your hand, and cut out.
6. Once plate is dry, glue your yellow construction paper hand, with fingers pointing up, onto the middle of the plate.
7. Next glue the cross so that it is partially on the grass and partially on the yellow hand.
8. Lastly using a black Sharpie, write the phrase: "He is Risen!" in the grass.

## Games

### Ninja

#### **Objective**

Be the last ninja standing

#### **Rules**

All the people are standing tightly in a circle. They rub their hands together in a ninja pose until the leader says "hiiiiya!". As soon as the leader says hiya, everyone jumps back and freezes into a 'ninja' pose. The first person or the leader makes the first move. They attempt to gently hit the person's hand to the right or left of them but they can only do so in one move. After their attempt, they must freeze in the position they end up in. The person whose hand they are attempting to hit has one move to avoid the hit. The next person then attempts to hit the hand of someone else in the circle. Once both of someone's hands have been hit, they are eliminated.

### Chain Reaction

#### **Rules**

Separate into 2 teams, stand in two lines, holding hands with your team. At one end an object such as a stuffed animal is placed on a chair or stool. At the other end 2 people are looking at the leader who is flipping cards from a deck. When a face card is dealt, the two at the end squeeze the hand they are holding, setting off a chain reaction that ends with the last student grabbing the object from the chair or stool. The team that grabs the object first gets to rotate the line so a new person is at the front. A false grab (someone squeezed when they shouldn't have) rotate backwards one spot. The first team to rotate through a decided upon number of times, wins!

## Disney Song Challenge

### **Rules**

2 teams are established. Someone plays the role of Disney DJ. Different Disney songs are played at random. As soon as someone from one of the teams knows the title of the song (or for simpler rules, knows the movie) they run to complete a task assigned by the DJ. These tasks can be as simple as finding a soup ladle to something as complicated as jumping to one location in the house on one leg and make it back. Get creative! The team that completes the task first gets to guess. If correct they win a point. The team that reaches the agreed upon score first, wins!
